Soccer Program Dates:

Registration Begins	July 16th-August 25th
Evaluations Begin	August 27 for 4-5 yrs, August 28 for 6-7,
Evaluations Begin	August 29 for 8-9, August 30 for 10-11
Coaches meeting 6-8pm	4-5 yrs and 6-7 September 5, 8-9 and 10-11 September 6
Coaches Training 9am	September 8
Practices begin	September 10
Games begin	September 22

Practices— will be held one to two times a week, based on age. They will be held from 5:30pm-6:45pm, or 6:45pm-8pm depending on age Monday—Thursday. The fields that will be used will be at Carl Barton Jr. Park and will be scheduled by your coach before the season starts.

Games — All games will be played at Carl Barton Jr. Park every Saturday starting at 9am.

The League — 4&5, 6&7, 8&9, 10&11 year olds will play an in-house schedule against Conroe teams. No Records are kept and no tournaments to decide league champion will be played. The league is geared for fun so please keep that in perspective!

Uniforms — Every child will receive a soccer jersey top. Players and Parents will provide shorts and socks.

Equipment — Soccer shoes are not required. Shin guards are required. No screw in cleats.

Teams Formation — All players must attend evaluations. Teams will be created for parity after evaluations and coaches will receive roster at coaches meeting. **You will get a phone call from your coach who will give you details about practices and other information. If you have not heard from a coach by September 10th please call 936-522-3900.**

Player's play time — All players will play at least half of every game. In all divisions, all coaches will have players play and vary the positions. In the 10-11 division coaches will try to play all members of the team in every game in positions geared toward the individual player.

What if it rains — For Practices during the week your coach will decide if your teams have practice. Please call your coach if you are unsure if practice will be held or call the rainout line at 936-522-3920. On Saturdays, please come to the field approximately 30 minutes prior to your game if you have any questions regarding play. You will be contacted by coaches regarding any rainout or weather situations.
