## Mandatory Stage 2 Water Restrictions

### Monday, January 2, 2012



The static level of several of the city's water wells have dropped significantly from 2010 to 2011. The water usage for 2011 has been the highest on record, with the wells running 24/7 due to the extreme drought conditions the entire state of Texas is experiencing. The city council has authorized the City of Conroe to go into *Stage 2 mandatory water restrictions*. This will allow the wells to recover and minimize the significant static water drops that are currently being experienced.
