CONROE FIRE AND POLICE RESCUE 2 VICTIMS FROM BURNING HOUSE

Conroe, TX: The City of Conroe Fire Department was notified of a residential structure fire in the 300 block of S. Sandra St. at approximately 1:20 am on December 26, 2011.

Conroe Police arrived first on scene and were able to pull one adult male victim from the structure. Conroe Fire units arrived soon after to find the structure heavily involved in fire. Conroe Firefighters were able to remove the second victim, an adult female, soon after their arrival. Both victims were transported, by ground, by Montgomery County Hospital District (MCHD) EMS to Memorial-Hermann Hospital in the Houston Medical Center.

Rapid response by Conroe Police, Conroe Firefighters, and MCHD EMS Paramedics led to the rescue, treatment, and transport of both victims. The latest information available, at the time of this release, listed both victims in critical, but stable, condition.

The fire was brought under control at approximately 2:03 am. The City of Conroe Fire Department Fire Marshal's Office has begun investigation of the fire's origin and cause. The investigation is actively ongoing. No further information pertaining to the investigation will be released at this time.
